What day/time are the sheds on?

Cockenzie – Monday 11 am to 1 pm at Cockenzie in bloom, Primary School Grounds EH32 0BY

Musselburgh – Tuesday 2 pm to 4 pm, Lady or Lorreto Church Newbigging Musselburgh EH21 7AJ

Dunbar – Wednesday 10:30 am to 1 pm Belhaven Parish Church EH42 1NH

North Berwick – Wednesday 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm at North Berwick Community Centre EH39 4PN

Tranent – Thursday 11 am to 1 pm Community Garden, 1 The Heugh, Tranent EH33

Haddington – Thursday 2pm to 4pm, Made in East Lothian EH41 3JW

Is there a referral form?

No – as men (women) can self-refer there is no referral form, to make it as easy as possible to come along. **But if you can ensure you bring some emergency contact details just in case.**

Can people just come along?

Yes – people can just come along, when they arrive if they ask for Mark, or make it known to the other shedders they are new they will show them around.

Does it cost?

£1 per time- everyone puts a pound in to cover tea/coffee milk etc, and this also contributes to the tools costs.

What do you do at a shed?
