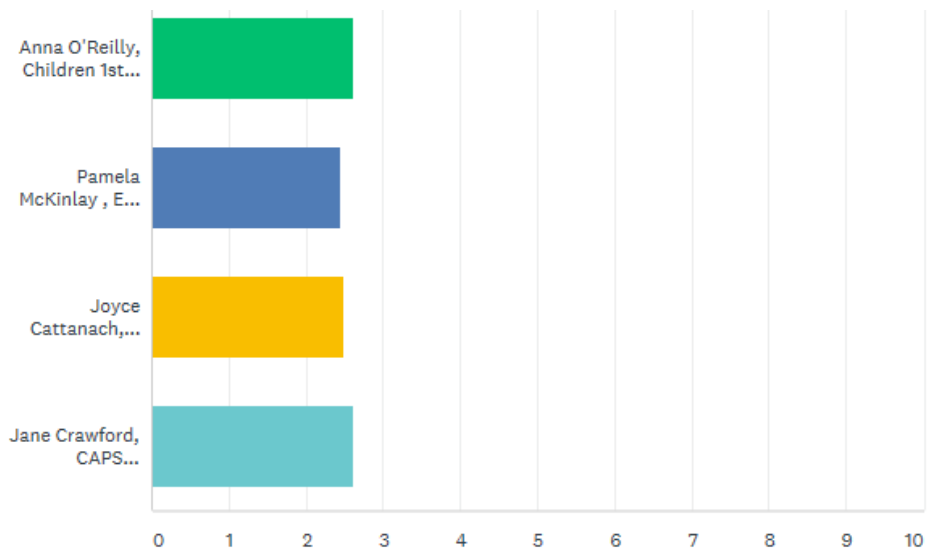
Where any changes are made to health and social care or community planning structures, delegates will be transferred to the most appropriate group.

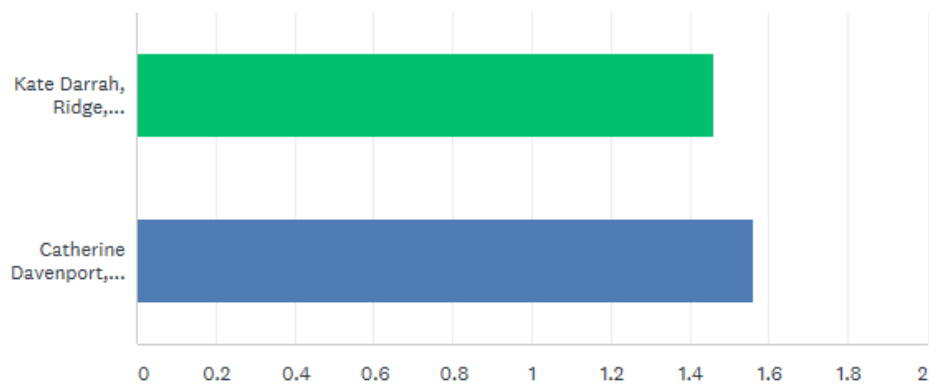
The Vote

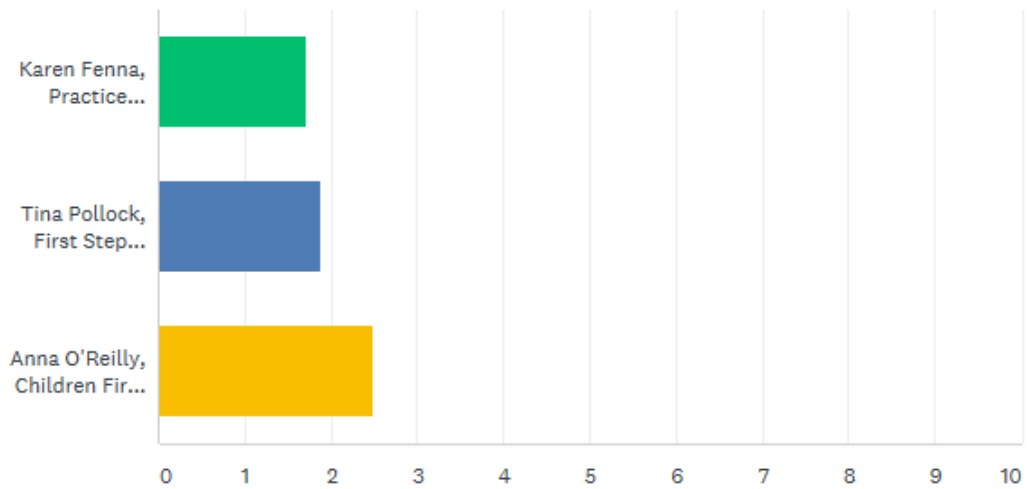
Resilient People Partnership



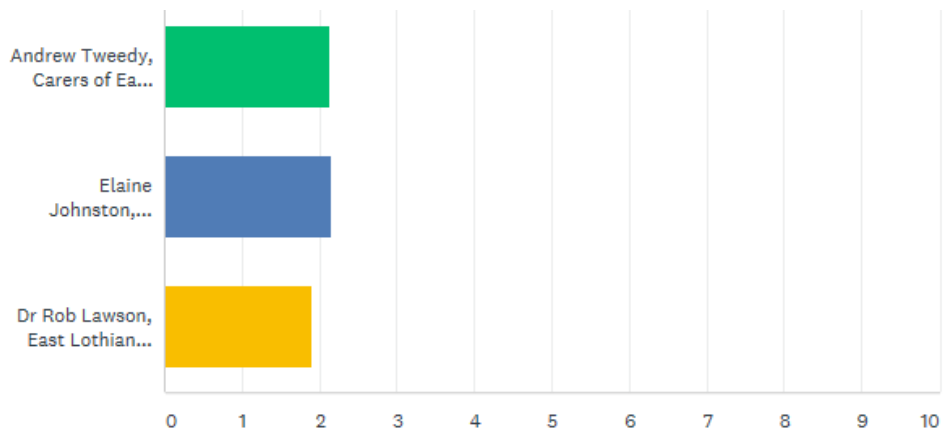
Sustainable Economy Partnership



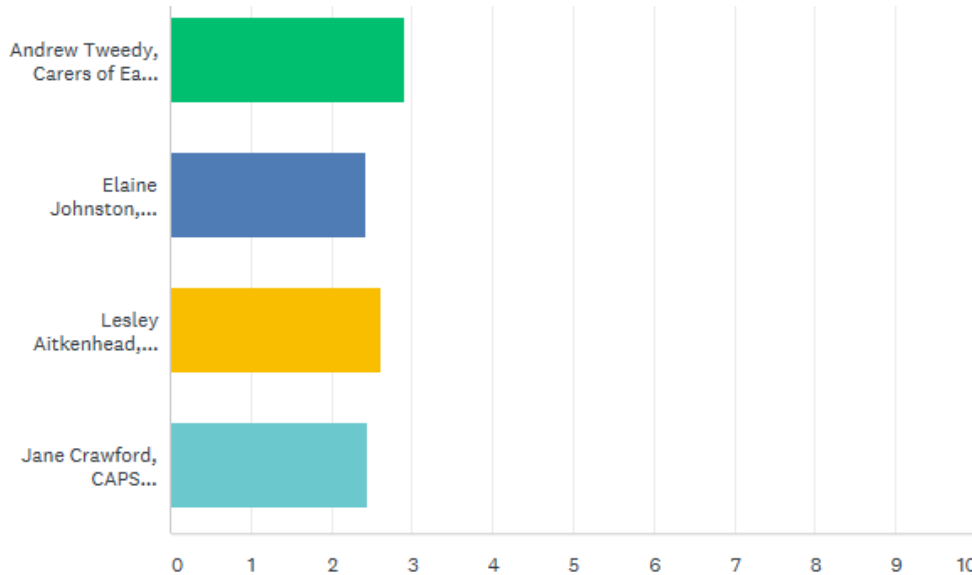
Children's Strategic Partnership
